Description of the Summer Horsemanship Program: Beginner through Advanced lessons daily. The age limit for boys and girls is 10, unless special permission is given prior to registration. The hours of camp will be 8:00am to 5:00pm (full day) and 8:00 am to 1:30pm (half day). Monday through Friday. Horse show on Saturday is optional. The show hours are 8:00am to 12:00pm. Please bring your own lunch and snacks. We will provide plenty of cold water. Each session will have daily horsemanship (mounted and unmounted) instruction; as well as, games, arts/crafts and demonstrations from vets, farriers and dentists. Our instruction will be in hunter/jumper, combined training and vaulting. Field trips may be arranged once a week. Wednesday is sleepover night (optional). Please make certain that your child brings a changes of clothes and that all items are labeled with their name.
